Did Colombia implement anti-dumping findings and recommendations in 2023?

Colombia claimed to have implemented the findings and recommendations of both through its Ministerial Resolution of 21 November 2023. Through this resolution, Colombia revised its original determination to address adverse findings but concluded that anti-dumping duties should continue with adjusted dumping margins.

Did Colombia impose anti-dumping duties on frozen fries?

The compliance panel ruled in favour of the EU on the claim that Colombia acted inconsistently with its WTO obligations when calculating and imposing anti-dumping duties on frozen fries from several EU Member States.

Did Colombia artificially inflated dumping margins by using WTO-incompatible methodologies?

However, the EU considered that Colombia artificially created and/or inflated the dumping margins by using WTO-incompatible methodologies and therefore requested compliance consultations with Colombia on 31 May 2024. Case on EU website

What happens if Colombia complies with WTO rules?

If adopted, the report will become binding between the EU and Colombia, and Colombia will have to take swift action to implement the ruling. In the absence of full compliance by Colombia, the EU will at any time be able to request the WTO to authorise suspension of concessions or other obligations to induce full compliance.
