Power available in wind is proportional to the cube of wind speed. A small increase in wind speed (from building taller towers) produces a massive increase in available power.

Wind turbines use blades to collect the wind's kinetic energy. Wind flows over the blades creating lift (similar to the effect on airplane wings), which causes the blades to turn.

Historically, wind power was used by sails, windmills and windpumps, but today it is mostly used to generate electricity. This article deals only with wind power for electricity generation. Today, wind power is generated almost completely using wind turbines, generally grouped into wind farms and connected to the electrical grid.

Wind energy is a form of carbon-free, renewable energy, which today makes electricity at a lower average cost than any other form of new-built energy.

Wind power is a "form of energy conversion in which turbines convert the kinetic energy of wind into mechanical or electrical energy that can be used for power," according to Noelle Eckley ...
