Will US tariffs affect solar panels imported from Southeast Asia?

The USA Leaders 23 April 2025 Washington, DC - In a sweeping move that's sending ripples through global energy markets, the United States has announced significant tariffs on solar panels imported from Southeast Asia.

How much does a solar panel cost abroad?

A solar panel that costs \$100 abroad could now cost \$130-\$150 in the U.S., pushing residential and commercial installation costs up by thousands. While manufacturing jobs may rise slightly, studies show 5 installer jobs are lost for every factory job gained. From 2017 to 2021, SEIA estimates 62,000 solar jobs were lost due to previous tariffs.

Why did the US impose a tariff on solar panels?

The U.S. government finalised steep levies on imports of solar cells and modules from Vietnam, Malaysia, Thailand and Cambodia in April, following two rounds of tariffs in June and November last year, to prevent dumping by mostly Chinese-owned factories in these countries.

Do 'anti-circumvention' tariffs on solar panels have to be paid?

They do not have to be paid on cells and modules that are already subject to separate 'anti-circumvention' duties on equipment that Commerce found in an earlier Auxin investigation is being manufactured in southeast Asia using Chinese parts to avoid high tariffs on solar equipment manufactured wholly in China.
